

## Cub Scout Denner

The Cub Scout Denner is a role that is intended to teach leadership skills. The responsibility is given to a den member as assigned by the Den Leader. Each month, a new Denner is selected. The Denner is easily recognized as he will be wearing a special Denner shoulder cord. (Left Shoulder)



His responsibilities are determined by the Den and Pack leader and will include:

### Den Meetings:

- Lead Flag and Pledge of Allegiance ceremony
- Assist Den Leader with Den activities
- Hold the Flag

### Pack Meetings:

- Assist with gathering activity
- Lead Den in skit (if part of meeting)
- Assist Cub Master to pass out achievements to Den

### Go See It/Pack Events:

- Set a good example for scouting behavior
- Inform other scouts of what they should be doing and where they should be going.

In General, the purpose of this role is to build leaders so Den Leaders should encourage and promote this role.
